APPROVAL OF THE JUNE 3 AND JUNE 18, 2019 MINUTES: Mark Farley made a motion and was seconded by Dale Welch to approve the June 3 and June 18, 2019 minutes. All present voted yes. Motion carried.

Mayor Wiggins stated that once we receive the monies, then we will have to bid the paving out and that the roads that will be paved are Old Walton Rd., New Ave, Railroad Ave., Peter Ave. and Elm Street down to Stratton.
