THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF MONTEREY, PUTNAM COUNTY, TENNESSEE, MET IN REGULAR SESSION AT THE MONTEREY MUNICIPAL BUILDING OF SAID TOWN ON AUGUST 3, 2020, AT 7:00 PM.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Bill Wiggins, III.

There being a quorum present, and so declared, the following business was transacted:

**APPROVAL OF THE JULY 6, 2020 AND JULY 20, 2020 MINUTES:** Nathan Walker made a motion and was seconded by JJ Reels to approve the July 6, 2020 and July 20, 2020 minutes. All present voted yes. Motion carried.

**CONSIDERATION OF BILLS:** Mark Farley made a motion and was seconded by Nathan Walker to pay the bills as listed. After a roll call vote, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

**CONSIDER RESOLUTION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PUBLIC ENTITY PARTNERS "SAFETY PARTNERS" MATCHING GRANT PROGRAM:** Mark Farley made a motion and was seconded by Charles Looper to pass this Resolution. After a roll call vote, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

**CONSIDER 2019-2020 BUDGET ADMENDMENTS:** Nathan Walker made a motion and was seconded by James Foster to pass the 2019-2020 budget amendments. After a roll call vote, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

**MAYOR'S REPORT:** Mayor Wiggins yielded the floor to Nathaniel Green and Duane Jarrett. Nathaniel Green gave an update on his meeting with TDOT and they are willing

repave the shoulder. He stated that with this information, the total cost from Ironwood Construction would be \$574,350 and the city would be out around \$130,000. He is estimating that the paving would be between \$50,000 and \$80,000 and that would be paid for with a grant. After more discussion, Mark Farley made a motion and was seconded by JJ Reels to move forward with this ARC project. After a roll call vote, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

Duane Jarrett stated that they have pulled the Turban out of the intake and it took \$8,600 to fix.

Mark Farley asked how the water is at the new lake? Duane Jarrett stated that it's about full right now.

Mayor Wiggins asked Duane to go ahead and inform the board about the letter that we received today. Duane Jarrett stated that we are going to have to send letters out again because we were over the limit again. The limit is .080 and we were at .0805.

**COMMITTEE REPORTS:** There was none.

**NEW BUSINESS:** There was none.

**PUBLIC COMMENT:** Charles Way addressed the board about his water bill being too high and also about the ditches not being mowed and the flooding because the ditches are not cleaned.

**ADJOURNMENT:** Mayor Wiggins adjourned the meeting.
